

Señorío = Vivir a Dios **Lordship = Experiencing God**

Act 2:36 ESV Let all the house of Israel therefore know for certain that God has made him both Lord and Christ, this Jesus whom you crucified."

Act 2:36 RVG Sepa, pues, ciertísimamente toda la casa de Israel, que a este Jesús que vosotros crucificasteis, Dios le ha hecho Señor y Cristo.

Mat 22:36-40 ESV "Teacher, which is the great commandment in the Law?" (37) And he said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. (38) This is the great and first commandment. (39) And a second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself. (40) On these two commandments depend all the Law and the Prophets."

Mat 22:36-40 RVG Maestro, ¿cuál es el gran mandamiento en la ley? (37) Jesús le dijo: Amarás al Señor tu Dios con todo tu corazón, y con toda tu alma, y con toda tu mente. (38) Éste es el primero y grande mandamiento. (39) Y el segundo es semejante a éste: Amarás a tu prójimo como a ti mismo. (40) De estos dos mandamientos pende toda la ley y los profetas.

Mat 10:37-39 ESV Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me, and whoever loves son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me. (38) And whoever does not take his cross and follow me is not worthy of me. (39) Whoever finds his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life for my sake will find it.

Mat 10:37-39 RVG El que ama padre o madre más que a mí, no es digno de mí; y el que ama hijo o hija más que a mí, no es digno de mí. (38) Y el que no toma su cruz y sigue en pos de mí, no es digno de mí. (39) El que hallare su vida, la perderá; mas el que perdiere su vida por causa de mí, la hallará.

Mat 16:24-26 ESV Then Jesus told his disciples, "If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow me. (25) For whoever would save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will find it. (26) For what will it profit a man if he gains the whole world and forfeits his soul? Or what shall a man give in return for his soul?"

Mat 16:24-26 RVG Entonces Jesús dijo a sus discípulos: Si alguno quiere venir en pos de mí, niéguese a sí mismo, y tome su cruz, y sígame. (25) Porque el que quiera salvar su vida, la perderá; y el que pierda su vida por causa de mí, la hallará. (26) Porque, ¿qué aprovechará el hombre, si ganare todo el mundo, y perdiere su alma? O, ¿qué recompensa dará el hombre por su alma?

Lordship leads to Knowing God through experiences of obedience.

Joh 17:3 ESV And this is eternal life, that they know you the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you have sent.

Joh 17:3 RVG Y ésta es la vida eterna: Que te conozcan a ti, el único Dios verdadero, y a Jesucristo, a quien tú has enviado.

Seven Realities of Experiencing God

1. God is always at WORK.
2. God pursues a RELATIONSHIP with you.
3. God invites your INVOLVMENT in His work.
4. God speaks in various ways to reveal HIMSELF.
5. God's invitation leads to a crisis of BELIEF that requires FAITH and ACTION.
6. You must ADJUST your life to join God's work.
7. You know God as you OBEY Him and He works THROUGH you.

Jesus' Example

1. The Father has been working right up until now.
2. Now the Father has Me working.
3. I do nothing on My own initiative.
4. I watch to see what the Father is doing.
5. I do what I see the Father doing.
6. The Father loves Me.
7. He shows Me everything He is doing

7 Truths from Experiencing God

- God is at work around you
- God pursues a love relationship with you
- God invites you to join Him
- God speaks to you
- Your crisis of belief
- You must adjust your life
- You can experience God

Lordship = doing God's work for His good pleasure = Experiencing God

Php 2:9-13 ESV Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, (10) so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, (11) and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. (12) Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, so now, not only as in my presence but much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling, (13) for it is God who works in you, both to will and to work for his good pleasure.

Php 2:9-13 RVG Por lo cual Dios también le exaltó hasta lo sumo, y le dio un nombre que es sobre todo nombre; (10) para que al nombre de Jesús, se doble toda rodilla; de los que están en el cielo, y en la tierra, y debajo de la tierra, (11) y toda lengua confiese que Jesucristo es el Señor, para la gloria de Dios Padre. (12) Por tanto, amados míos, como siempre habéis obedecido, no como en mi presencia solamente, sino mucho más ahora en mi ausencia, ocupaos en vuestra salvación, con temor y temblor, (13) porque es Dios el que en vosotros obra así el querer como el hacer, por *su* buena voluntad.

Rom 10:9-10 ESV because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. (10) For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved.

Rom 10:9-10 RVG Que si confesares con tu boca al Señor Jesús, y creyeres en tu corazón que Dios le levantó de los muertos, serás salvo. (10) Porque con el corazón se cree para justicia, mas con la boca se hace confesión para salvación.
