- Over 200+ received ministry @ four events with healings and Holy Spirit impartations

Although a quick trip, Dennis ministered at three churches, speaking to the bible students, meeting with the We3B youth group with 80+ attendance, and traveling into the mountains to the church plant in Patleket. The purpose of this trip was to build up the local Nepali leaders and to survey a church plant-sponsored discipleship training program supported by Mission River. The host Upasana Methodist Church is building a discipleship training center teaching the Gospel with music instruction. Students spend 8-10 weeks before returning to their villages. I attended the graduation ceremony and issued a completion certification to eight students. I brought over 60lb of English Theological Books and 20 USB drives full of over 700+ PDF books from Christian Authors. They requested these training materials because everyone under the age of 25 has learned English as a second language since primary school. On Saturday (The Nepali Worship Day), he spoke at two churches and one leadership group. God's hand was upon this mission and saved him not once but twice from dangerous perils. The Holy Spirit did a mighty work; opening deaf ears, healings, and many were imparted with His presence. Thanks for joining this mission in prayer. AMEN!
