In Christ, I am a new creation.

"Therefore if any person is ingrafted in Christ they are a new creation a new creature altogether. Therefore as a new creation, my old moral and spiritual condition has passed away. Behold, the fresh and new has come into me.

I am a new creation in Christ Jesus!" AMEN!

(From 2 Cor. 5:17 AMP)

In Christ, I am forgiven of my sins.

"I will be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God, in Christ, has forgiven me. I will forgive those that hurt me and everyone who believes in Christ will receive the forgiveness of their sins.

In Christ my sins are forgiven, AMEN!"

(From Eph. 4:32; Act. 10:43)

In Christ, I am redeemed and justified.

"I am being justified by His grace through the redemption in Christ. I believe in Jesus who justifies the ungodly. My faith is credited to me as righteousness. By His doing I am in Christ Jesus, who has become to me wisdom, righteousness, sanctification, and redemption.

I know that I am not justified by the works of the Law but through faith in Christ Jesus." AMEN!

(From Rom. 3:24, 4:5; 1 Cor. 1:30; Gal. 3:22)

In Christ, I boast of His redemption.

"Therefore in Christ Jesus, I have found the reason for boasting in things pertaining to God. For this reason, I endure all things for the sake of those who are chosen so that I may obtain the salvation and eternal glory in Christ Jesus. In Him, I have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of my trespasses, according to the riches of His grace, AMEN!" (From Rom. 15:17; 2 Tim. 2:10; Eph. 1:7)

In Christ, I am dead to sin.

"For the law of the Spirit of life has set me free from the law of sin and of death. I consider myself dead to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus.

Therefore there is now no condemnation for me because I am in Christ!" AMEN! (Rom. 6:11, 8:1-2)

In Christ, I am without sin.

"I know that Jesus appeared in order to take away sins, and in Him, there is no sin. Because I abide in Him, my sin is no longer counted against me. Because no one who is born of God practices sin and His seed abides in me and I am born of God in Christ Jesus!" AMEN! (From 1 Jo. 3:6, 9)

In Christ, I am blameless.

"I have been sanctified in Christ Jesus. And by His doing, I am in Jesus, who became to me righteousness, sanctification, and redemption. I have righteousness, not of my own, but that which is through faith in Christ. Jesus has saved me and called me with a holy calling, not according to my works, but according to His purpose and grace which was granted from all eternity. I have the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ. Because God made Him who knew no sin to be sin on my behalf, so that I might become the righteousness of God in Him. Just as He chose me before the foundation of the world and that I would be holy and blameless in Christ!" AMEN! (From 1 Cor. 1:2; 30; Phi. 3:9; 2 Tim. 1:9; Rom. 3:22; 2 Cor. 5:21; Eph. 1:4)

In Christ, I die, and I am made alive.

"I affirm, by the boasting I have in Christ Jesus, I die daily. I am a fool for Christ's sake, I am weak, and without honor for Christ. In Him is life, and the life is the Light of men.

For as in Adam all die, so now in Christ, I have been made alive, AMEN!" (From 1 Cor. 15:22, 31, 4:10; John 1:4)

In Christ, He abides in me.

"So that the name of our Lord Jesus will be glorified in me, I am in Him, according to the grace of God. I partake in communion by eating His flesh and drinking of His blood. I now abide in Him and He in me. I am a branch to the Vine. And in Christ, I will bear much fruit, for apart from Jesus I can do nothing. I am a child of God and with this confidence, I do not shrink away from His coming. He has given the Holy Spirit to abide in me.

I believe God loves me. For God is love and His love abides in me, AMEN!" (From Acts 17:28; 1 Jo. 2:28, 3:24, 4:13, 16)

In Christ, I am seated with Him in the heavenly places.

"And now in Jesus, I was formerly far off but now I have been brought near by the blood of Christ. Jesus was crucified because of my weaknesses, yet He lives because of the power of God. For I am weak in Him, yet I will live with Him because of the resurrection power directed toward me.

In Christ, I have been raised up with Him, and I am now seated with Him in the heavenly places!" AMEN! (From Eph. 2:6,13; 2 Cor. 13:4)

In Christ, I have eternal life.

"I believe, God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life. I drink the water that springs eternal life. Everyone who beholds the Son and believes in Him will have the life. I will be raised up with Christ on the last day. For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life.

I have found mercy and testify to this, that God has given me eternal life in Christ!" AMEN! (From John 3:15-16, 4:14, 6:40; Rom. 6:23; 1 Tim. 1:16; 1 Jo. 5:11)

"In Christ Jesus, the blessing of Abraham have come upon me so that I would receive the promise of the Spirit. I believe the Gospel that I am now sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit. "Indeed, all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will be persecuted. Therefore, I will keep a good conscience so that when I am slandered Christ will put them to shame.

Because, after I have suffered for a little while, the God of all grace, who called me to glory in Christ, will Himself perfect, confirm, strengthen, and establish me. For to me, it has been granted for Christ's sake, not only to believe in Him but also to suffer for Christ's sake!" AMEN! (From 2 Tim. 3:12; 1 Pet. 3:16, 5:10; Phi. 1:29)

In Christ, God supplies all my needs.

"With a view to the fullness of the times, that is, the summing up of all things in Christ, things in the heavens and things on the earth. In Him I have obtained an inheritance, having been predestined according to His purpose who works all things after the counsel of His will, to this end I am the praise of His glory. "He who believes in Christ will not be disappointed. But thanks be to God, who always leads me in triumph in Christ, and manifests through me the sweet aroma of the knowledge of Jesus in every place, AMEN!" (From Rom. 9:33; 2 Cor. 2:14)

In Christ, I am filled with peace.

"And the peace of God, which surpasses all comprehension, will guard my heart and mind in Christ Jesus. And the graces of my Lord will abide in my faith and so that I will love those who are in Christ Jesus!" AMEN! (From Phil. 4:7; 1 Tim. 1:14)

In Christ, I shall never be separated from the love of God.

"Nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, will be able to separate me from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus my Lord!" AMEN! (Rom. 8:39)

In Christ, I am complete.
