Mar 16:15-18 RVG Y les dijo: Id por todo el mundo y predicad el evangelio a toda criatura. (16) El que creyere y fuere bautizado, será salvo; mas el que no creyere, será condenado. (17) Y estas señales seguirán a los que creen: En mi nombre echarán fuera demonios; hablarán nuevas lenguas; (18) tomarán serpientes; y si bebieren cosa mortífera, no les dañará; sobre los enfermos pondrán sus manos y sanarán.

Mar 16:14-20 ESV Afterward he appeared to the eleven themselves as they were reclining at table, and he rebuked them for their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they had not believed those who saw him after he had risen. (15) And he said to them, "Go into all the world and proclaim the gospel to the whole creation. (16) Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned. (17) And these signs will accompany those who believe: in my name they will cast out demons; they will speak in new tongues; (18) they will pick up serpents with their hands; and if they drink any deadly poison, it will not hurt them; they will lay their hands on the sick, and they will recover." (19) So then the Lord Jesus, after he had spoken to them, was taken up into heaven and sat down at the right hand of God. Luk 18:35-43 ESV As he drew near to Jericho, a blind man was sitting by the roadside begging. (36) And hearing a crowd going by, he inquired what this meant. (37) They told him, "Jesus of Nazareth is passing by." (38) And he cried out, "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!" (39) And those who were in front rebuked him, telling him to be silent. But he cried out all the more, "Son of David, have mercy on me!" (40) And Jesus stopped and commanded him to be brought to him. And when he came near, he asked him, (41) "What do you want me to do for you?" He said, "Lord, let me recover my sight." (42) And Jesus said to him, "Recover your sight; your faith has made you well." (43) And immediately he recovered his sight and followed him, glorifying God. And all the people, when they saw it, gave praise to God.

On **Sunday**: the Team was sent to three different churches. Laura had arranged for a special women's meeting and with 40+ attendees. Dario and Nincy were sent to a very remote church that only had a tin roof overhead and had to walk two miles from the car to the meeting. She dropped her stick and profusely kissed me and our team as both her eyes came open! "I can see! I can see!" Glory to the King of Kings.

On our return we stopped at my translators grand papa's house who was not feeling well. He was a retired Mennonite minister and need prayer for a stomach pain. We prayed and he was healed.

(7) Jesus *said to him, "I will come and heal him." (8) But the centurion said, "Lord, I am not worthy for You to come under my roof, but just say the word, and my servant will be healed. (9) "For I also am a man under authority, with soldiers under me; and I say to this one, 'Go!' and he goes, and to another, 'Come!' and he comes, and to my slave, 'Do this!' and he does *it.*" (10) Now when Jesus heard *this,* He marveled and said to those who were following, "Truly I say to you, I have not found such great faith with anyone in Israel.
