For God did not give me a spirit of FEAR, TERROR, TORMENT, WORRY, and ANXIETY but Jesus Christ has given me the of power and of love and of calm and well-balanced mind and discipline and self-control. I know that Jesus warned that "the prince, the evil genius, the ruler of this world" would come. I now declare that the Devil and his demons have "no claim on Me." They have nothing "in common with me" and "there is nothing in me that belongs" to the Devil. I declare that I am Christ's both inside and out. Jesus, the Messiah, is my Lord and Savior. "His evil spirits have "no power over me. I renounce any and all claims the Devil may have upon me. I now announce that all demons must leave my body because of Christ's work upon the cross, the blood, and the empty tomb. In Jesus Christ's name, I pray. And I bind and cast out all demons of FEAR, TERROR, TORMENT, WORRY, ANXIETY and any other evils spirits tied to them by the authority of Jesus I now send them to His feet, AMEN. I now claim that the cross and the empty tomb be placed between me and these evils spirits and forbid them or any other demons from returning in Jesus' name. I know that I am blessed because I do not walk in the counsel of the wicked, Nor stand in the path of sinners, Nor sit in the seat of scoffers!
