

Prayers of Faith

(Please pray these aloud and follow Jesus' example in Mat. 6:7-15 and the Psalms. Faith increases by hearing the WORD!!)

Confession of Faith!

God, I know I am separated from You because of my sin. The only way to You is through the crucified blood of Jesus Christ. Who died upon the cross for my sins and arose from the dead on the third day. I confess I am a sinner and ask for Your forgiveness and cleansing through my repentance. I now declare I am going to live the new life that is only found "In Christ." I begin by asking Jesus to show me how to love You with all my heart, with all my soul, with all my mind, and with all my strength. In Jesus' Name, I Pray, AMEN! (From 2 Cor. 2:8-9; Act. 2:28, 3:19-20).

The Lord's Prayer

"O' Lord, Holy, Holy, Holy is Your name. May Your kingdom come, and Your will be done in my life and family. ABBA, Father God, I pray that Your will on earth will be as it is in Heaven. Show me the steps of Yours to take today and tomorrow. May I understand the words, messages, and revelations from the Holy Spirit. Lord, You know my daily needs. I thank you for Your divine provisions. May You show me how I can bless others just as You have poured out blessings upon me. O' Lord I thank You for showing me how I can forgive those who have hurt and disappointed me. Jesus help me make the decision of my will to forgive them and that these sins will not be counted against them. Lord may You also forgive me and show me how to clean the heart. May I walk blameless before You. I pray for Your spiritual protection. Please do not lead me into temptation but deliver me from the evil ones, lest I stumble and fall upon the rocks. May my family be protected and held closely in Your arms. Give Your angels charge over me, my (wife/husband), my children, and [Name others] as we go out today and tomorrow. O' Lord, I ask in the blessed name of Your Son Jesus Christ, AMEN!" (From Mat. 6:7-15; Psa. 91, 23, 32).

Grace

I proclaim my life in Your Son Jesus Christ and that Your graces, loving-kindness, favor, and goodness will richly rest upon my family and me. I ask for Your grace, regardless of my outward and earthly circumstance. You are the God, who can make every earthly blessing and favor, will cause me to come into Your abundance and that I will be furnished for every good work. I am beloved of God and as His saint, I am called to consecrate my life so that every spiritual blessing will be mine according to my Father who is in Heaven, AMEN!

(From Act. 4:33; Psa. 24:3-4; 2 Cor. 9:8; Rom. 1:7).

Faith

Lord Jesus, may You increase the mustard seed of my faith so that it would and become a fruit-filled tree of righteousness. I confess that I have had little faith and ask for your forgiveness for not believing Your word. You have said that if I have the faith of a little mustard seed and say to this mountain "move" and it will move, and nothing will be impossible for me. I pray that You increase my faith so that [Name issue] will be done according to my faith and Your word! AMEN! (From Mat. 17:20; Rom. 12:3).

Peace

I have been justified by faith and now have peace with God through my Lord Jesus Christ. I come to YOU weary and heavy-laden so that You will give me rest. For I know Your yoke is easy and Your burden is light. Lord Jesus place now upon me Your peace and quiet my troubled heart. I give to You all my fears, and I will let my requests be known to You. I now take Your yoke upon my shoulders so that I would learn from You. I know You are gentle and will give rest to my soul. Lord bless and keep me. May Your face shine upon me and be gracious in giving me peace. And the peace of God, which surpasses all comprehension, will guard my heart and mind in Christ Jesus, AMEN! (From Rom. 5:1; Mat. 11:28-30; Joh. 14:27; Phi. 4:6-7; Num. 6:24-27).

Family and the Lost

Dear Heavenly Father, I lift up [Name] for you have known him/her from the foundation of the world and are with them today. Jesus proclaimed release to the captives and You will set them free. Jesus proclaimed liberty to those who are blind and oppressed I choose now to accept this promise and pray that You tear down every strong hold of evil that is holding [Name] captive.

God, send Your Holy Spirit to open their eyes so that they turn from darkness to light and from the power of Satan to You. That [Name] would repent, receive forgiveness of sins, and be clothed in white. So that Jesus will confess their name(s) before the Father and His angels.

For I will not walk according to my natural thinking but will enlist Your divine power to destroy any evils that wage war against [Name]. I acknowledge that every thought of theirs will be taken captive to the obedience and knowledge of Jesus Christ. I ask that You send ministering angels for their protection and guidance into the full knowledge of Your Son Jesus Christ, AMEN!

(From Luk. 4:18-19; Act. 26:18; 2 Cor. 10:3-5; Rev.3).

Healing and Health

[Read] "Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer of faith will save the one who is sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven. Therefore, confess your sins to one another...that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person has great power" (From James 5). [Confess any sins, take communion, and then pray the following.]

O' Jesus I come to You now that You will heal me of my disease and infirmity. [Name issue]. Heal me, O' LORD, and I shall be healed; save me, and I shall be saved, for you are my praise. Jesus said: "I will come and heal him. I had compassion on them and healed their sick." I ask You now to come Lord Jesus and heal me! Because I know You were wounded for my transgressions; and crushed for my iniquities; and upon You were the chastisement that will bring me peace, and by Your stripes, I am healed. May the leaves of the tree of life bring healing to my body, my bones, my brain, and my soul. In the Name of Jesus Christ, I proclaim and receive my healing today. AMEN! (From Jas. 5:14-1; Jer. 17:14; Mat. 8:7; Isa. 53:5; Rev. 22:1-2).

Angelic Protection

O' Lord I am a poor man and I cry out in the midst of all my trouble. I call upon You, for You will answer me. O' God; incline Your ear to me; hear my words, show Your steadfast love to me because I seek refuge in You. Keep me as the apple of Your eye; hide me in the shadow of Your wings. O' Lord send angels to encamp around me and deliver me from the destruction of evil. Let this evil be like chaff before the wind, with Your angels driving them away! Let their evil ways be dark and slippery. God let loose Your burning anger, wrath, indignation, and distress, and release a company of destroying angels to come upon this evil that is set against me [or group].

Because I make the LORD my dwelling place--no evil shall befall me, no plague will come near me. For You will command the angels to guard me in all my ways. And on their hands, they will bear me up, lest I strike my foot against a stone. Because You my God, will allow me to tread upon the lion and the serpent trampling them underfoot. In the Name of my Savior, Jesus Christ, AMEN! (From Psa. 17:6-8, 91:9-13, 35:5-6, 78:49, 34:6-8).

Warfare Prayer

Dear Lord strike the match in the heavenlies and wage against [Specific issue]. May You command the lightening to strike the mark and defeat this evil. And Your brightness is like the sunlight; Your rays stream from Your hands, and in the sun like splendor is the hiding place of Your power. I know that in Christ is the Life; the Life is the Light of men, and Your Light will shine on this darkness. In the name of Jesus Christ, I proclaim [Specific issue] to be set aflame and defeated in the heavenlies and upon this earth by the power of Your Word and the resurrection of my Lord Jesus Christ, AMEN! (From Job 36:32; Hab. 3:4; Joh. 1:4-5).

Blessings and Praise

Blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of scoffers, but my delight is in the law of the LORD.
