"Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied."

(Matthew 5:6 ESV)

Slay Me:

"O' God, Slay me." "(Jesus) looked directly at them and said...'The stone that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone'? Everyone who falls on that stone will be broken to pieces, and when it falls on anyone, it will crush him.'" (Luk. 20:17-18 ESV) Even as a new creation in Christ, I am wrestling with my old wretched man and as long as my old sin nature prevails my prayers will be hindered.
